Bob will highlight his crew's launch aboard a Russian Soyuz ro cket from Kazakhstan and their subsequent rendezvous and docking with the ISS two days later. Working aboar d the Station within a collaborative and cross-cultural setting, Bob and his crew performed a variety of experim ents on behalf of scientists from around the world. He will describe the nature of daily life aboard a space statio n and conclude his presentation by recounting the crew's rollicking return to Earth at the end of their six-month odyssey.

Bio

Dr. Robert Thirsk received degrees in Mechanical Engineering, Medicine and Business Administration from the University of Calgary, MIT and McGill University. Bob has flown on two spaceflights: a mission aboard the sh uttle Columbia and an expedition aboard the International Space Station. Although he is now retired from active duty, he continues to promote a role for Canada in the delivery of remote health care to astronauts who will someday venture on missions to deep space. Bob also advocates for a national economy based upon exploration, innovation and lifelong learning.
